### Mass and toxic tort defense

Mr. Seley has defended clients facing a variety of mass tort/toxic tort claims in both State and Federal courts. Representative matters include:

- A “contaminated community” toxic tort case in Federal District court involving allegations of exposure to hexavalent chromium and TCE in air and groundwater.
