Challenges to Agency Action

Mr. Seley has represented clients and industry coalitions impacted by state and federal agency action. Representative matters include:

- A multi-circuit challenge to an EPA Clean Water Act rulemaking impacting the nation's pulp and paper industry.
- An APA challenge to a Department of Interior rulemaking on an agricultural payment-in-kind program.
- A challenge to the Department of the Interior's "Roadless Rule" that would have made more than 50 million acres of woodlands off-limits for active management.
- Clean Air Act challenges to California regulation of automobile emissions, and to Virginia adoption of California "Zero Emission Vehicles."
- Clean Air Act challenge to Vermont regulation of automobile emissions.
- A NEPA challenge to the Department of the Interior's efforts to take agricultural land for various projects in South Florida.
