The Swiss Arbitration Association awarded New York partner Rahim Moloo the 2024 [ASA Prize for Advocacy in International Commercial Arbitration](#), which recognizes “outstanding advocacy in international commercial arbitration.” With the objective of promoting the effective resolution of international commercial disputes through arbitration, ASA offers a prize at regular intervals for counsel who, through their exceptional talents in advocacy, contribute most effectively to this objective. As an organization with a wide-ranging international membership, including arbitrators, counsel, and users with extensive international arbitration practice, ASA sees itself as ideally placed to contribute to this objective by identifying and publicizing good examples of advocacy in international arbitration. One award is given every two years, and Rahim was named as the most recent laureate during the Swiss Arbitration Summit 2024 on February 1, 2024.
